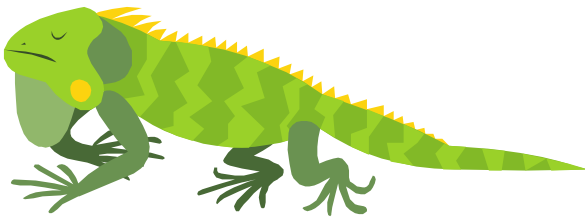

Inquisitive Iguanas

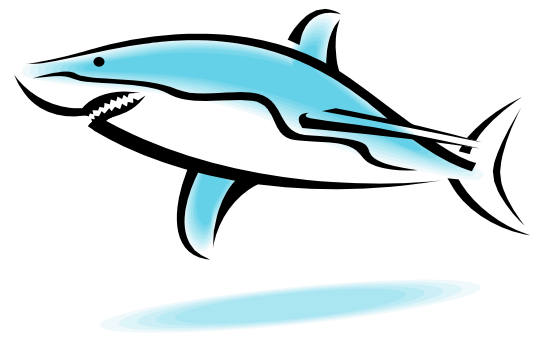

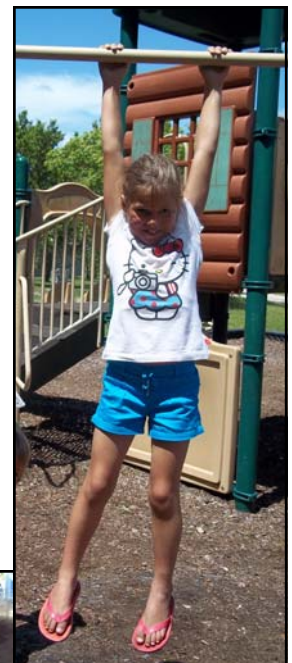
Super Sharks
