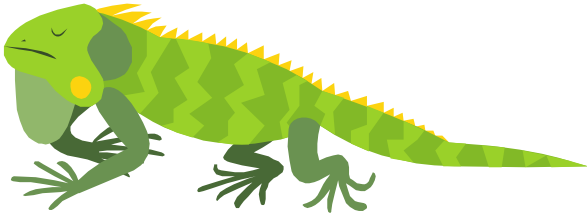

Inquisitive Iguanas

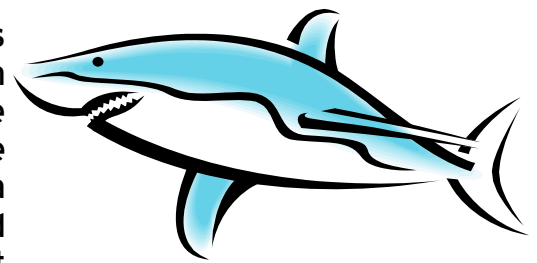
