Procedures and Policies

- **Deadline for submission is April 1st. Award notification will be May 1st. General Scholarship requests will not be reviewed unless a completed camper registration form and a \$50 non-refundable deposit are submitted through our on-line portal.** This deposit will go towards the camper registration fee and will be deducted from the total amount.
- Registration deposit is refundable in the event that a scholarship is not awarded.
- Award amount will be based on the Income Eligibility Chart. All families are required to make a minimum family program contribution and the \$50 deposit will be applied toward that amount.
- **Complete each section.** Incomplete applications will be returned. Use only one form per child. Scholarships apply to only one program, per child, per session. A new application must be completed each time. Applications can be submitted by mail, email, or fax.
