Procedures and Policies

- Deadline for submission is April 1st. Award notification will be May 1st. You will receive a confirmation of receipt upon submitting you application. Notifications of awards will be sent out after May 1st.
- All of the required forms MUST be submitted at once. Partial packets WILL NOT be accepted.
- The \$50 non-refundable deposit can be submitted through our on-line portal. This deposit will go towards the camper registration fee and will be deducted from the total amount.
- If a scholarship award is no longer available, the deposit will be kept as a credit on your account to use for a future application or camp session.
- Award amount will be based on the Income Eligibility Chart. All families are required to make a minimum family program contribution and the \$50 deposit will be applied toward that amount.
- Complete each section. Incomplete applications will be returned. Use only one form per child. Scholarships apply to only one program, per child, per week. A new application must be completed each time. Applications can be submitted by mail, email, or fax.
