### **Fun in the Sun ; All things Solar**

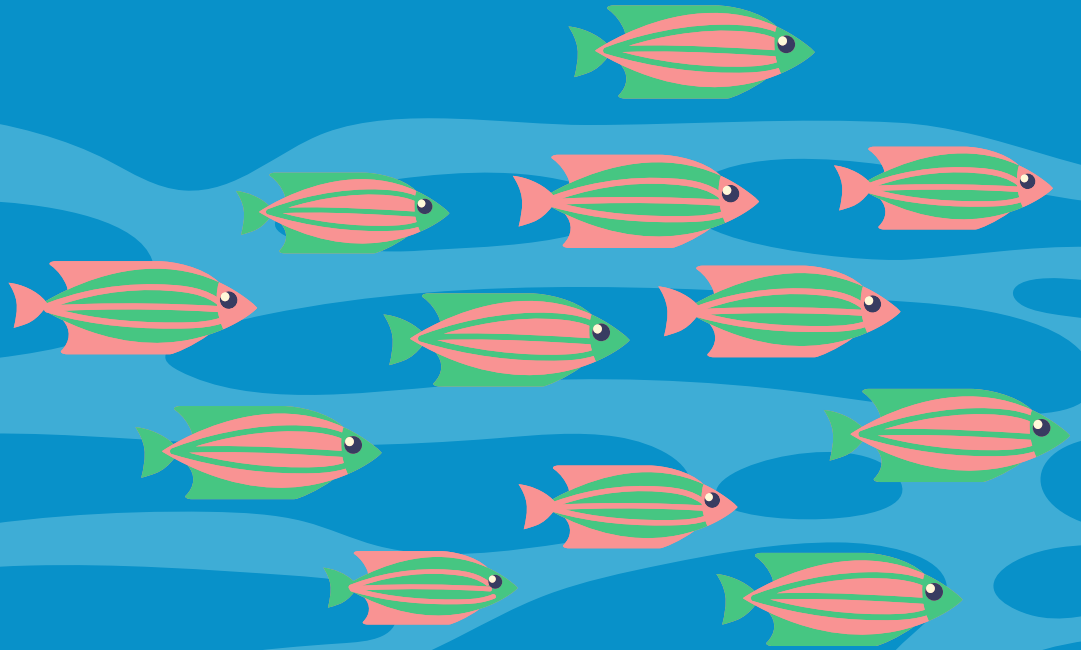
Let your camper soak up the fun in "Fun in the Sun," exploring all things solar and the power of the sun! **Field Trip: Jungle Island**

## WEEK 10 (AUGUST 11–15) :

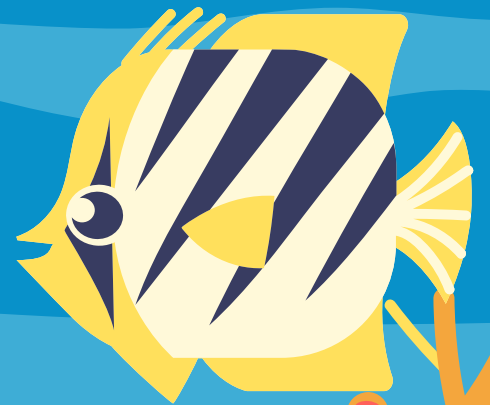
### **Rock On! Geology and Volcanology**
